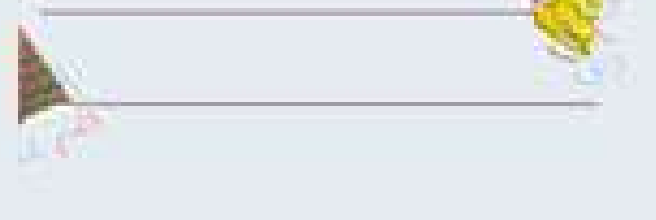
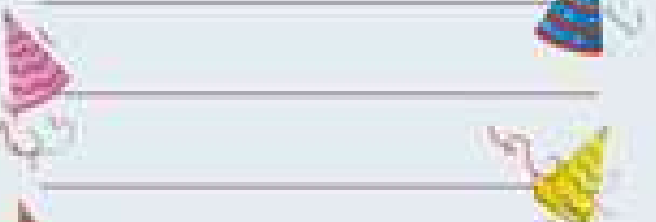
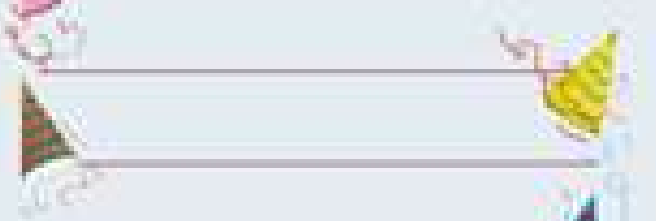
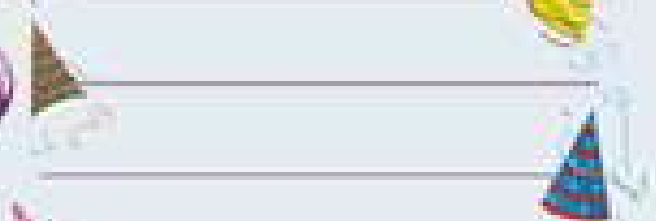
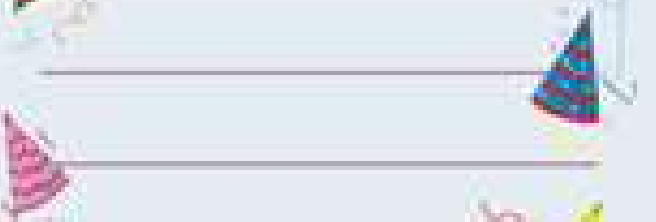
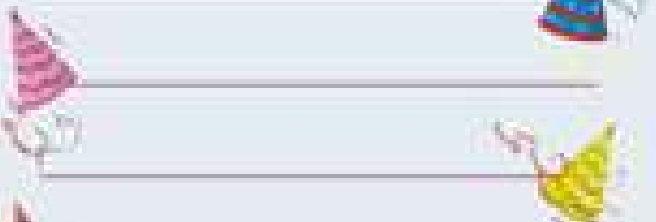
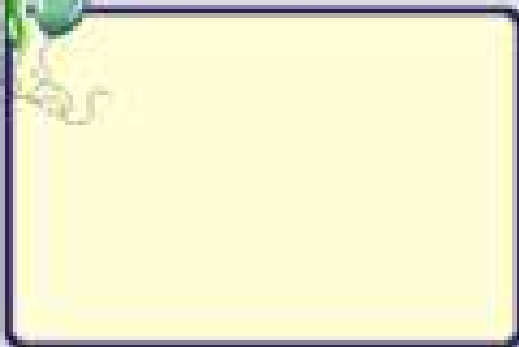
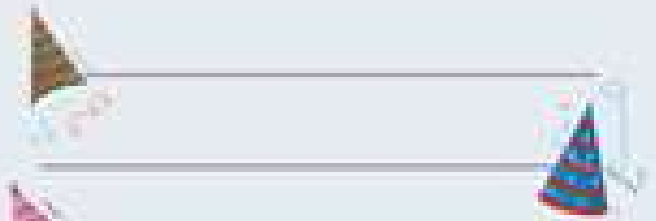
When they looked at the sky again, this time raising their heads and hands to thank God, they actually saw a pretty face, winking at them. Who was that...? Nobody seemed to know.

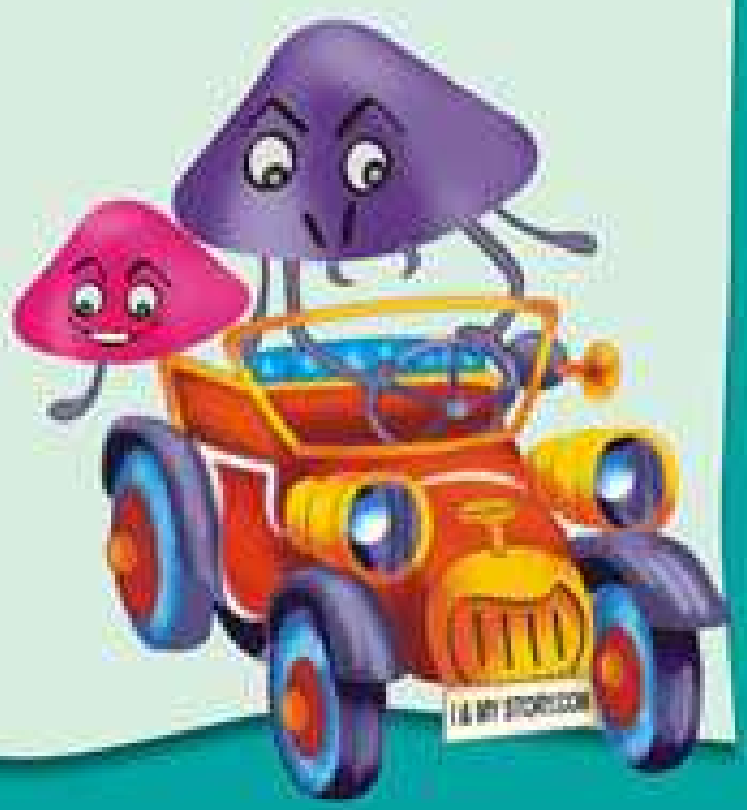
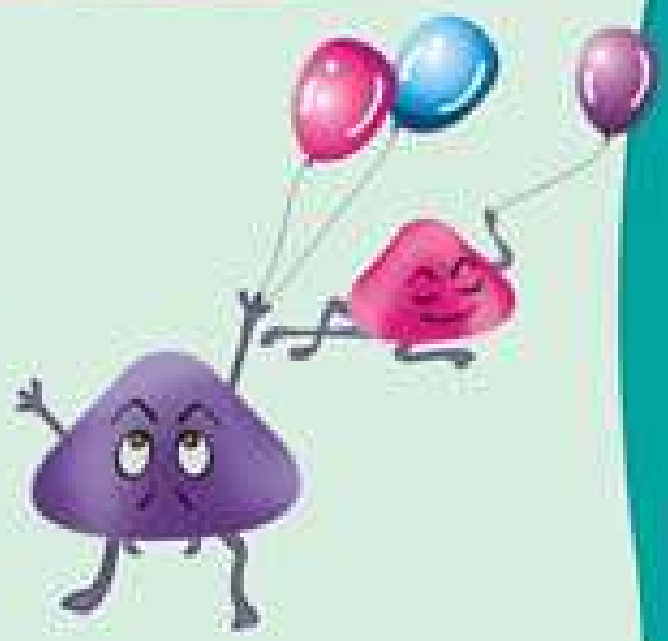
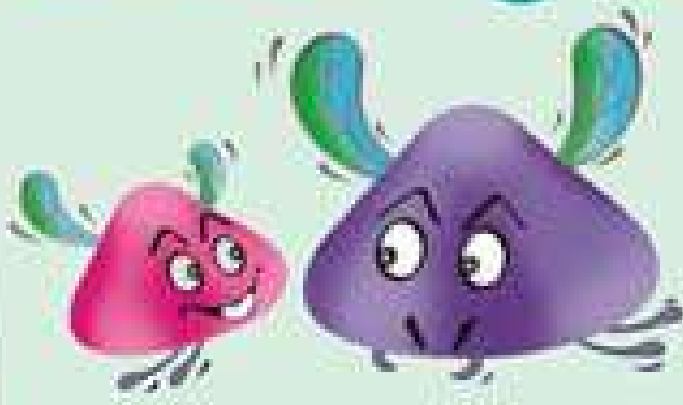
