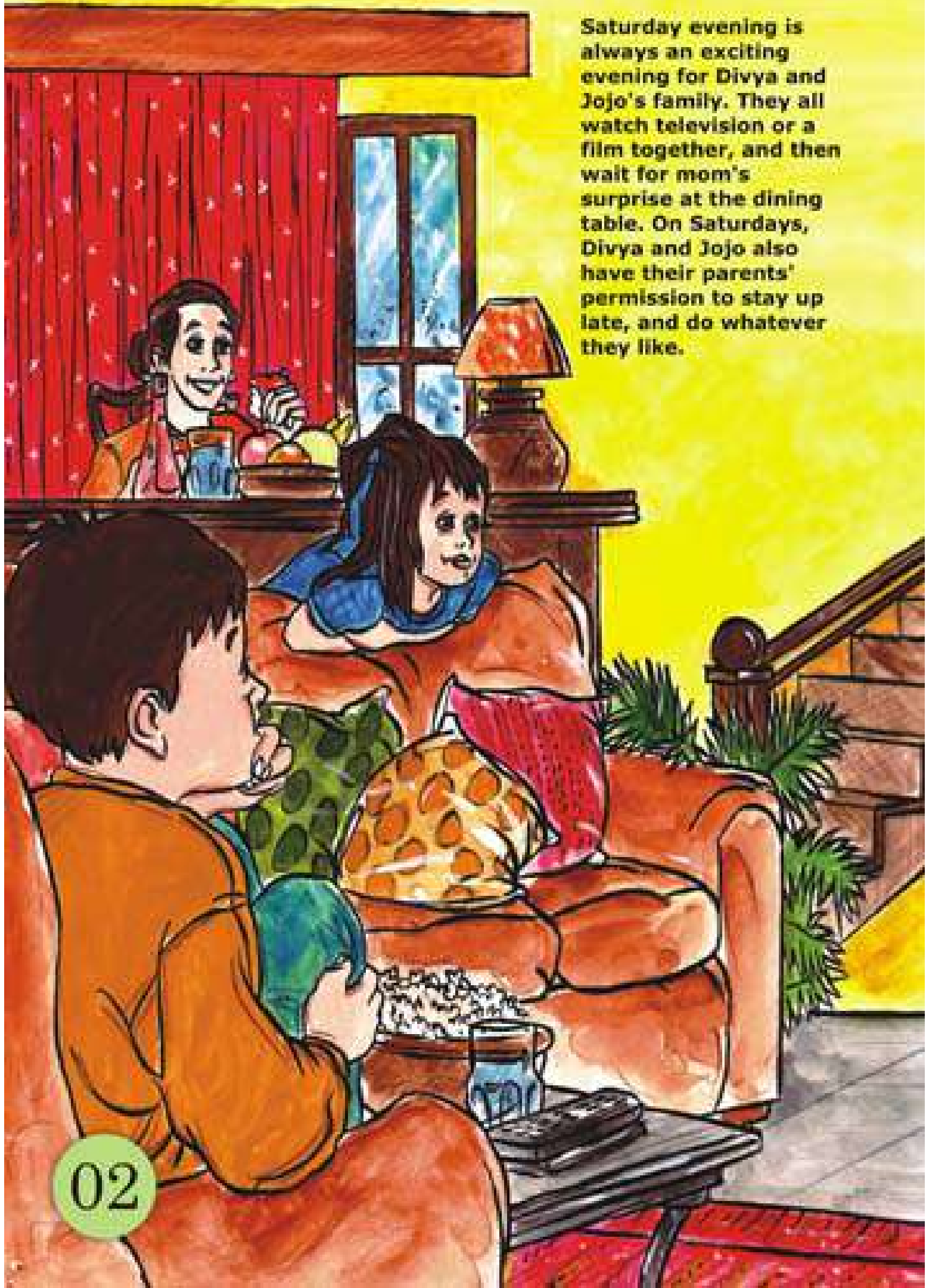
Dear Divya

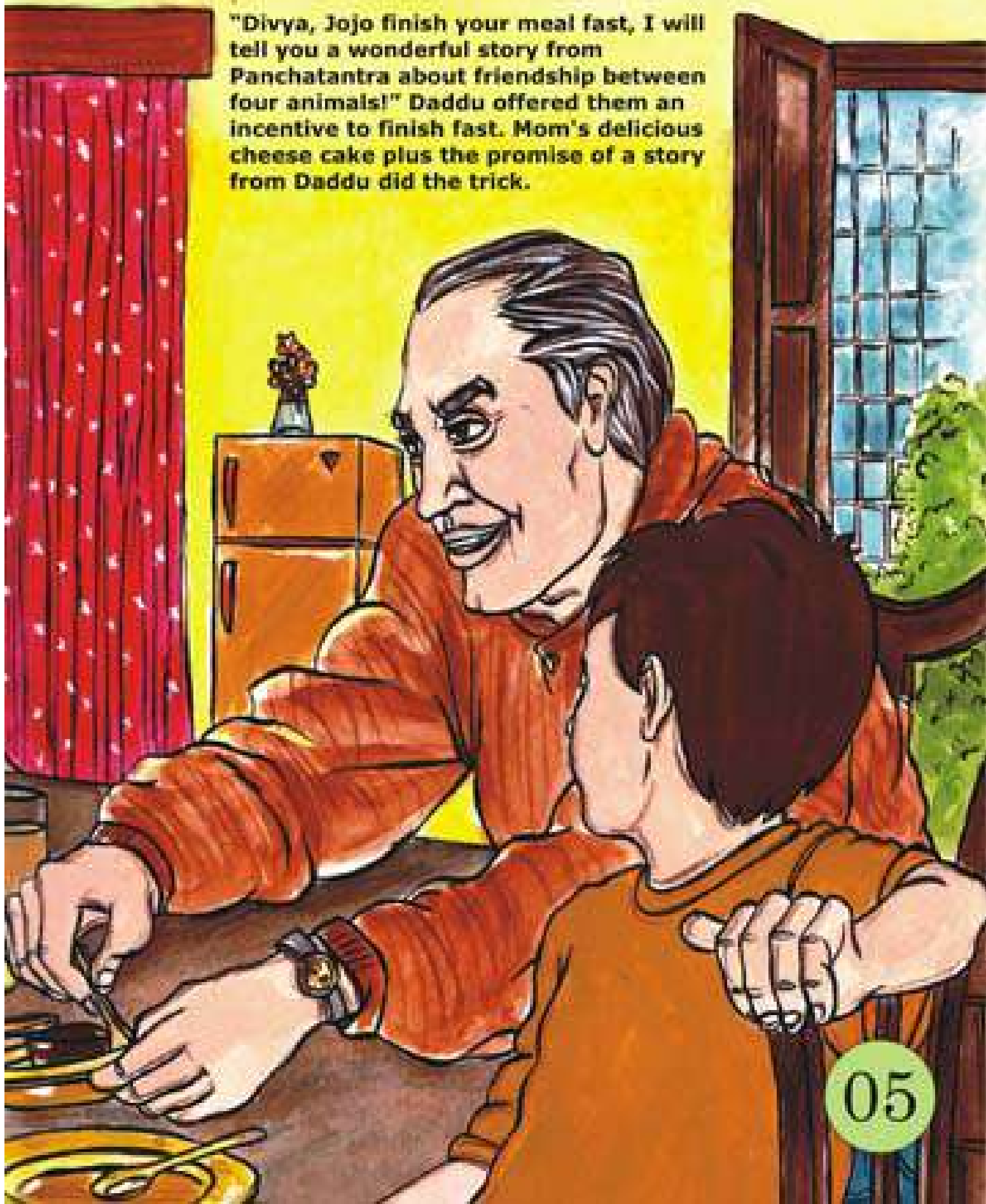

The cub was playing so beautifully with the rabbit, taking care not to hurt it..." Divya chirped animatedly.



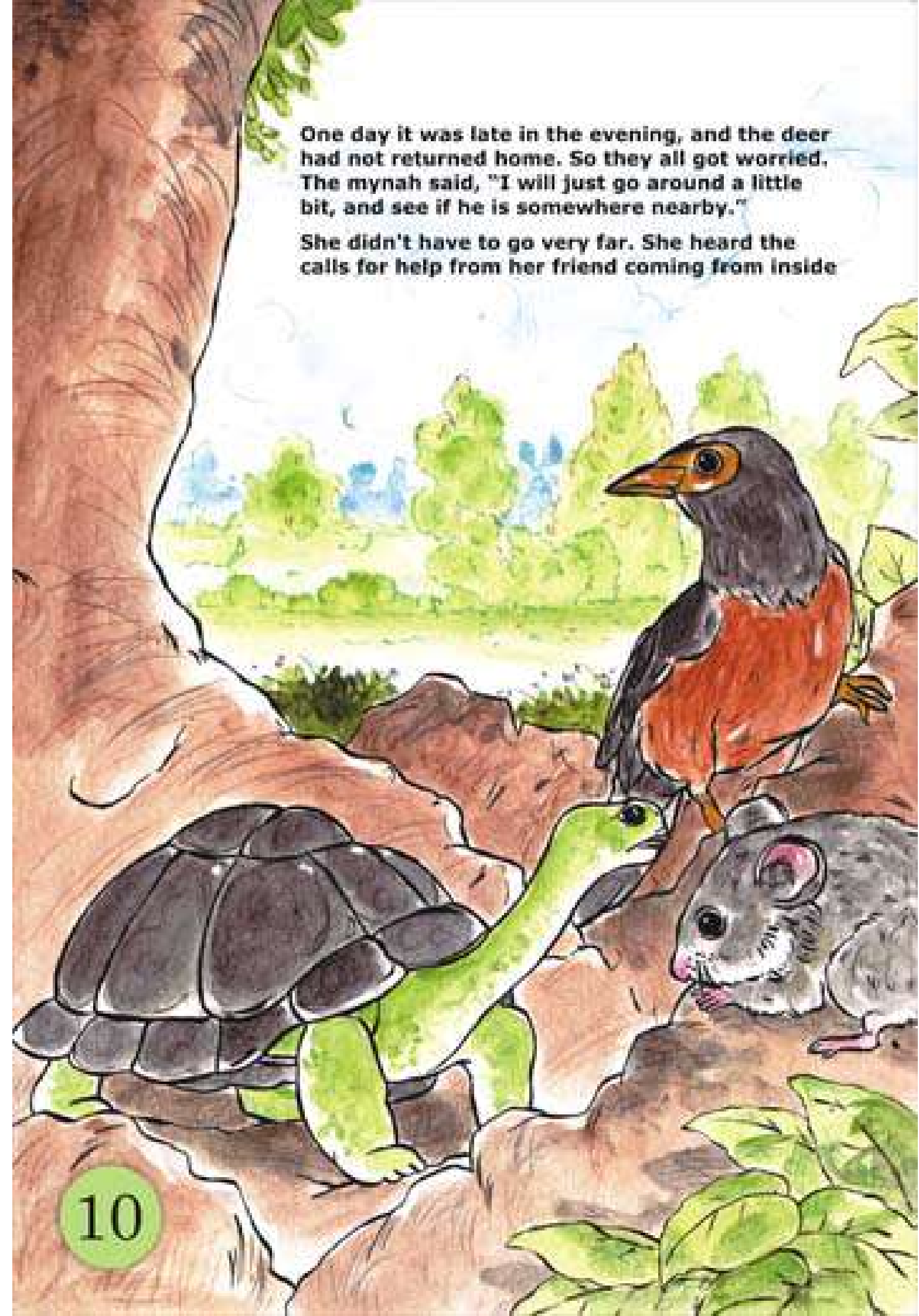

She didn't have to go very far. She heard the calls for help from her friend coming from inside



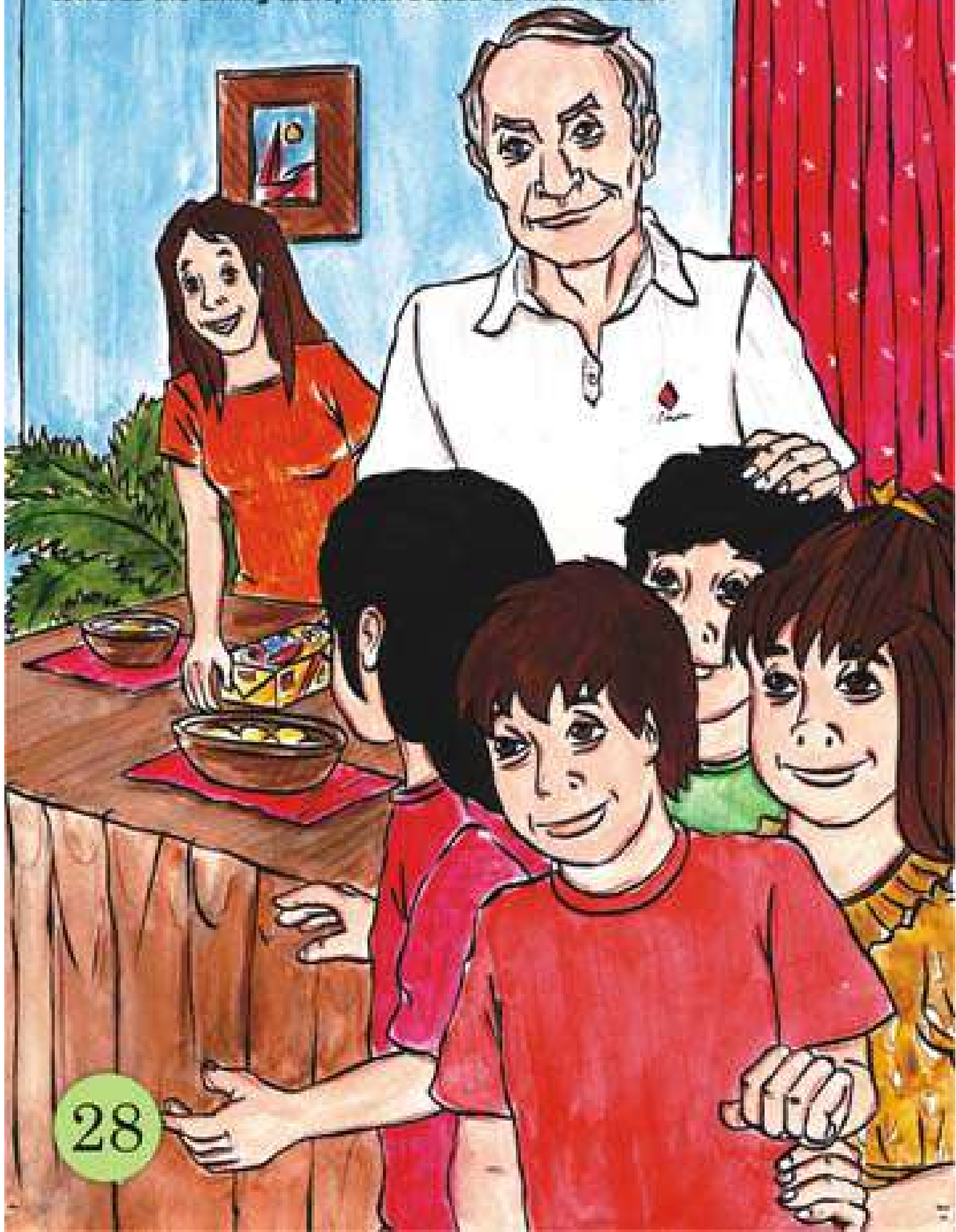
